

Arrange for Grenadiers' Homecoming

Members of the Winnipeg Grenadiers reserve battalion here have received no word of any official Grenadier representation at Manila when first battalion prisoners-of-war are released, The Tribune was informed today.

While no plans have yet been made for a reception when the prisoners return to Winnipeg, arrangements are under way.

It is understood the Grenadiers' ladies' auxiliary will take the lead and will be assisted by the reserve battalion.

M.D. 10 authorities told The Tribune today that no word has been received from Ottawa in reply to the suggestion that an occupying Canadian unit in the Far East be given the name, Winnipeg Grenadiers.

The suggestion was first put forward here by Col. E. S. Russenholt, officer commanding the reserve battalion. The suggestion was forwarded to the officer commanding M.D. 10, who in turn forwarded it to Ottawa.
