

# HONG KONG PRISONERS MOVED

SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 25—  
(AP)—The majority of Allied prisoners and internees held at Hong Kong—many of them Canadians -- now have been transferred to Shanghai and other ports to await the arrival of Allied ships, Japan's Domei agency said today in a broadcast recorded by the Federal Communications Commission.

The dispatch said "excellent" treatment is being given the Allied prisoners and internees and that some, with "special" reasons, have even been permitted to leave their camp.
