

PRINCE ROBERT STEAMING TO HONG KONG FOR PRISONERS

MANILA, Aug. 28—(CP)—
The big Canadian anti-aircraft cruiser Prince Robert is steaming toward Hong Kong where she was due to arrive late Monday with medical supplies, food and clothing for Canadian prisoners of war and internees, it was learned here.

It was possible that the Prince Robert, a pre-war Pacific coast passenger ship, might be used to transfer some of the Canadian and Allied prisoners back to this port.

It was reported here that the Canadian cruiser Ontario also was in neighboring waters, possibly with the combined Allied fleet that steamed into Sagami bay, south of Tokyo, today.
