War Nearly Doubled British Workers' Income

LONDON, Sept. 6—(CP)—Average weekly earnings of British factory workers rose 76 percent during the war, increasing from £2 13s 3d (about \$11.90) in October, 1938, to £4 13s 9d (about \$21) in January, 1945, according to figures published in the Ministry of Labor Gazette.
