Several more Winnipeg families have received further news of Hong Kong men, some in personal cables.

Mrs. D. H. Pollock, West apts., got a wire from Guam: "Am flying home, Love, John." That is her son, Pte. John Pollock.

Mrs. George Trist, 266 Queenston st., got one from Calcutta from her husband, Maj. Trist: "Fit and well. Expect to see you all soon."

Mrs. Gladys McBride, Spadina court, heard her husband, Pte. Thomas McBride, was officially reported safe with the Allies. There are two small children, Carol and Barry. The soldier's parents are Mr. and Mrs. T. McBride, 226 Good street.

Pte. Gordon Arthur Cole will be flying home soon, according to information received through the Red Cross by his mother, Mrs. R. Schas, 508 Church ave. A year ago last spring the soldier was heard on a short wave broadcast; his mother got 40 letters from listeners as well as a recording.
