3 Grenadiers Due Today in Vancouver

First three Winnipeg Grenadiers to set foot in Canada since they were taken prisoner by the Jap-anese on Christmas Day, 1941, were due to arrive in Vancouver

They are Pte. Harold A. Atkinson, whose mother, Mrs. Eva Linklater, lives at 385 Aikins st.; Pte. E. B. Arseneau, Fort Frances, Ont., and Pte. Ernest Buck, whose home is listed as St. Jerome, Que.

Mrs. Linklater said it was possible her son would have to spend some time in barracks here after returning. She said she did for know his physical condition as a result of treatment in Jap prison camps.

A wire came from Oakland, Calif., dated Sept. 12, saying he was leaving for Vancouver and should arrive home Sunday. He gets 42 days leave, plus traveling time.

Pte. Atkinson, 23, enlisted in May, 1940, and was captured on the fall of Hong Kong. Mrs. Linklater received four letters and a card from the Far East.

Another son, Cpl. Ronald Atkinson, Winnipeg Grenadiers, has not been heard from.

Both boys were born and educated in Selkirk and came to Winnipeg in 1931. They resumed their education here at Machray school.

Another member of the Grenadiers, Pte. Harry Gyselman, of 849 Spruce st., landed at Hamilton Field, San Francisco, Thursday, and will arrive at Vancouver later.

Pte, Gyselman was also captured at Hong Kong and was held in Niigata camp, where he was put to work in a foundry casting parts discal engines

Migata camp, where ne was put to work in a foundry casting parts diesel engines.

Following the arrival in Vancouver of the first group today, the men will be taken to the Little Mountain army depot where they will receive the medal ribbons for the 1939-40 Star and the Canadian Volunteer Service Medal with Maple Leaf clasp.

Defense headquarters in Ottawa said the men had been transported from the Far East "to a United States Pacific coast point and would reach Vancouver by train."

Headquarters said the men would be outfitted with clothing as required and would be medically examined.

494 MEN LISTED SAFE

CITTAWA, Sept. 14—(CP)—Defense headquarters Thursday night released its fifth official list, containing the names of 143 noncommissioned officers and men of the Canadian army liberated at Hong Kong where they were captured by the Japanese Christmas Day, 1941.

Names of many of the 1,500-odd Canadian soldiers held by the Japanese have been reported in recent news dispatches from that area but with this list a total of only 494 Canadian prisoners have been officially named as safe in Allied hands.
