4 MORE GRENADIERS RETURN

FOUR MORE Winnipeg Grenadiers, who were Japanese prisoners of war, returned home Tuesday evening over C.P.R. lines. Two are Winnipeggers: Pte. Harry Gyselman, 849 Spruce st., and Pte. John W. Campbell, Ste. 15 Adanac apts.

Another Manitoban, Pte. S. A. Birss, switched trains and went directly to his home at Dauphin. Another Grenadier, Pte. E. B. Arseneau of Fort Frances passed through Winnipeg en route to his home with six Royal Rifles men, who live in eastern Canada.

There were only a few hundred persons at the station to meet the men, in contrast to Pte. Atkinson's reception, but they were given a warm reception by those present.
