

45 Liberated Grenadiers Flown to San Francisco

2 Manitobans At Vancouver

SIXTY CANADIAN SOLDIERS, 45 of them Winnipeg Grenadiers, who were captured by the Japanese after the fall of Hong Kong, arrived in San Francisco by air Thursday.

Four other units of these Grenadiers arrived at Vancouver Friday. They were: Pte. W. Mitchell, Winnipeg; Sgt. T. Colton, Brandon; Pte. E. W. Wright, Toronto; and Grenadier Sgt. Blair, J. A. McLeod, Winnipeg, Ont., of the Royal Rifles.

The reports did not say how many more would have to come within days.

The group that arrived in San Francisco Thursday were flown here by the U.S. Army Air Transport Service. They are now awaiting transportation to Vancouver.

After temporary accommodations at Lake Mead near Las Vegas, Nev., will depart for their homes in Canada.

The arrival of these men brought to 111 the number of Canadian prisoners who have been returned to the mainland since the end of the Japanese war.

TWO MORE GRENADIERS LISTED AS LIBERATED

OTTAWA, Sept. 22--(CP)-- Defense headquarters Friday night issued its 11th official list containing the names of 13 Canadian Army personnel captured by the Japanese at the fall of Hong Kong.

The list brought to 930 the number of Canadians now officially named as liberated.

Ottawa also disclosed that 10 Canadian soldiers liberated in the Far East sailed for America from Manila, Sept. 15, aboard the steamer W. C. Longfitt.

The brief announcement did not estimate how long it would take the ship to reach port nor at which port she would dock.
