

348 Freed Men From Japan Leave Vancouver Sunday

The first special train for liberated prisoners from the Far East will leave Vancouver Sunday by Canadian Pacific lines for Winnipeg with 348 Canadian army officers and other ranks, bound for western and eastern Canadian points. The special will operate from the C.P.R.'s Vancouver terminal to Winnipeg, and personnel for eastern points will continue the trip aboard regular C.P.R. trains.

Seventeen cars, including 13 sleepers and two dining cars from regular service, will make up the special trooper which will initiate this special west-to-east rail movement of Pacific veterans.
