

Grenadier Dies Enroute Home

FLIN FLON, Oct. 8—Word has been received here of the death of Pte. Ken Jackson, Winnipeg Grenadiers, on his way home from a prison camp in Hong Kong. A message to relatives here a few weeks ago reported him alive and liberated. He contracted malaria and died after he left Manila.

His wife lives in Valparaiso, Sask., and his mother is Mrs. M. McNab, of Tisdale, Sask.

Pte. Jackson was employed here by the Hudson Bay Mining and Smelting Co. for a few months in 1939. He enlisted the day after war was declared.
