Jap-Held Mail Going to Manila

MANILA, Oct. 8—(CP Cable).— Two hundred bags of mail for Canadian prisoners in Japan, undelivered by their Jap captors, have been forwarded to the Canadian repatriation group here.

The bags, containing letters dated as far back as 1941, Red Cross and personal parcels, will be returned to Canada, as all but small groups of recovered prisoners are on their way home.

As the liberated Canadians passed through this reception base all but three of nearly 500 men received recent mail from home.
