

38 Grenadiers Leave 'Frisco For Victoria

SAN FRANCISCO, Oct. 15
— (CP) — Forty-nine of the group of 51 liberated Canadians prisoners of war who arrived in San Diego Friday aboard the U.S. transport Lamarr, passed through nearby Oakland Sunday night en route by train to Seattle, where they will transfer to a coastal service ship for Victoria.

The two other members of the group were left behind—one in hospital and the other one on furlough at his home in Long Beach.

Thirty-eight of the group are members of the Winnipeg Grenadiers.
