## 68 Liberated War Prisoners On Way to B.C.

SAN FRANCISCO, Oct. 17.-(CP).—A group of 68 liberate Canadian prisoners of war, includ ing 13 officers, boarded a train a nearby Oakland late Tuesday nigh for Seattle where they will transfer to a coastal service ship for passage to Victoria.

They will arrive in the B.C capital about noon Thursday.

They arrived here in two groups which landed Monday and Tuesday Capt. C. M. Thomson, Canadiar army staff, Tuesday estimated that more than 900 returning Canadiar soldiers have passed through this U.S. port within the last month having arrived by both sea and air

Auother U.S. ship, the Catron carrying 58 Canadians, is tentatively scheduled to arrive here Oct. 19.
