

Families Meet 4 Grenadiers

Four more Winnipeg Grenadiers, recently liberated from Japanese prison camps, returned home to their families Tuesday night over C.P.R. and C.N.R. lines.

They were: Pte. Neil McLean, 399 Kilbride ave., West Kildonan; Pte Joseph Pudlo, Brandon; Pte. Walter Schmal, 934 Pritchard ave., and Pte. J. H. Campbell, Alonsa, Man., who arrived on the C.N.R. train at 6.45 p.m

McLean, who was met by his two sisters, one sister-in-law, two brothers-in-law, three nephews, four nieces, two uncles, one aunt, eight cousins and a host of friends, was imprisoned at Kowasaki

Pte. Schmal was also held at Kowasaki working underground in the coal mines. He was in the camp hospital for a little while for malnutrition.

Pte. Pudlo, who was liberated Sept. 24, is finishing his 30 days' leave in Winnipeg. He will receive his discharge Thursday.
